At WBUUC, our youngest children learn about what it means to be a Unitarian Universalist in our world through a variety of experiences and settings in which they explore, wonder, worship, and do the work of faith formation in community.

From Sunday morning circles with peers to intergenerational worship and multiage programming, children have the opportunity to experience many different ways of Growing and Serving together.

Circle Sundays: Most Sundays, children are divided by peer groups where they will explore the monthly worship theme through stories, crafts, and games. These classes help our children not only learn about our faith, but helps them establish friendships with peers and connect with fabulous volunteer teachers who help to guide these circles throughout the year. On these Sundays, children begin the morning in the sanctuary and then leave for classes during the first hymn. Classes end at 10 after the hour.

Intergenerational Worship: All-ages worship in the sanctuary allows families to worship with one another and helps children learn hymns and rituals that are important to this community. On these Sundays children will remain in the sanctuary for the entire service.

Chapel Sundays: The first Sunday of each month, children will hear a story before leaving the sanctuary for a child-centered worship, and then return at the end of the service for the closing hymn and prayer. This allows children to experience worship and multigenerational community as well as age-appropriate learning and leadership. Occasionally, Chapel will be led with help from the junior high and senior high youth, with help from younger children who wish to get involved in presenting worship.

Social Action and Soulwork Sundays: On these special Sundays, prek-5th grade children come together to Grow and Serve. Occasionally led by our junior high and high school youth, this multi-age, centers-based approach allows children to explore our faith in a fun, interactive way.

Sunday Morning Religious Education programming for Prek-5th grade children takes place during both the 9am and 11am services from mid-September through June.
